In the face of increasing case numbers as a result of the Omicron variant, the Ministry of the Interior has issued a new circular regarding the necessity of PCR tests for intercity travels under certain circumstances.


People who have not been vaccinated against the virus, have not completed their vaccination process, or have not had COVID-19 in the last 180 days will continue to be **asked for a PCR test result ahead of their intercity flights**.

Adventure lovers can now feel their hearts race while ziplining and taking in a dazzling view of the Bosporus.


