KU Booster Dose Mandate



KU Booster Dose Mandate

According to the new guidelines, all students currently residing and are planning to stay at the dormitories are **required to have booster vaccine doses** prior to returning to campus for the Spring Semester.

You are required to have your booster vaccine dose (a third dose) by **February 7, 2022,** and upload your updated vaccine card to the system prior to this date.

If you were diagnosed positive for COVID-19 in the last 3 months, you do not need to get the booster shot. However, you are required to submit the relevant positive PCR test result, that shows that you have had COVID-19, prior to February 7, 2022.

Residence Permit Document Submission

This month, ICO will be organizing a **Help Desk** for residence permit applications on **Monday**, **14 February**, **and Tuesday**, **15 February**, **from 9 AM to 5 PM**.

The Help Desk will be located at the **Student Center, -3** Floor, Room B336.

Important notes:

- Spring semester exchange students should <u>only</u> follow the information given at the orientation and via email.
- Before the submission date, you should fill out the **Document Submission Form** and you should show the screenshot of the filled form while submitting your documents to the Help Desk.
- You can renew your SRP if there is 60 days or less time to the expiration of your SRP.
- Late submissions will not be accepted. Please mind the document submission date and time. Missing the deadline means waiting for the next document submission date.
- Applications with missing documents or data will not be accepted. Make sure you doublecheck the list of required documents on our <u>website</u>. Having a missing document will cause you to wait until next month's document submission period. If your visa/visa exemption period expires, this delay may result in a fine that you will need to pay. Therefore, it is very important to make sure your documents are complete.
- It is mandatory to use a biometric (in ICAO standards) photograph in the residence permit applications. You can find the ICAO standards on our <u>website</u>, in the list of required documents on the relevant pages.
- You should stay in Turkey until your application gets evaluated. If you depart before, your application will get rejected automatically.
- If you are making a late application, please make sure that you write and attach a **letter of excuse** in Turkish (Template can be found on our website, in the list of required documents on the relevant pages.)
- Please mind the <u>campus entry regulations</u> to enter campus.

Man's best friend is taking on a new and important role: Sniffing out the coronavirus to help detect possible cases in Turkey.

Istanbul-based Sadi Konuk Training and Research Hospital and Istanbul University Cerrahpaşa Faculty of Veterinary Medicine along with TAV Security have concluded a study which they have been conducting for about a year.


